15-Minute Dinner Recipes

It can be mentally taxing to prepare for daylight saving time. Now that we are springing forward and losing an hour, it can be even more of a challenge to find time to prepare a tasty and nutritious home-cooked meal. [HuffingtonPost.com](#) provides 15-minute recipes to help us stay on time:

15-Minute Skillet Lasagna

Ingredients:

1/2 lb. lean ground beef, 2 cups diced onion, 2-3 garlic cloves (minced), 1 bag of pre-cooked turkey sausage crumbles, 8 oz. lasagna noodles, 1 can diced tomatoes, 1 cup tomato sauce, 2 cups water, salt and pepper to taste, 1 cup mozzarella cheese (shredded), 4 oz. fresh mozzarella pearls

Directions:

In a large skillet, cook the ground beef and onion over medium-high heat stirring occasionally until

browned. Stir in minced garlic and cook for one minute. Evenly add the pre-cooked sausage, lasagna pieces, tomatoes, tomato sauce, and water over the skillet. Sprinkle evenly with salt and pepper. stir gently to combine. Cover and simmer for 15 minutes over medium to medium-low heat. Shake the skillet occasionally to evenly distribute noodles as they soften. Remove from heat and stir in cheese. Top with mozzarella pearls and broil for 3-4 minutes until golden.

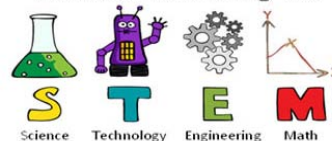
Georgia Cares

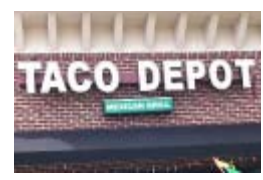
