ATI TEAS Testing Process

Gwinnett Technical College



The Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS) measures basic skills in academic content areas of Mathematics, Reading, Science, English and Language Usage.

Candidates for all Imaging Sciences including Radiologic Technology, Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Cardiovascular Technology, and Echocardiography Technology programs are required to take the ATI TEAS Exam before the published file completion deadline.

SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT TO TAKE THE ATI TEAS EXAM:

- The ATI TEAS exam must be completed prior to the File Completion Application deadline for your selected program. **The minimum score that will be accepted is 70** in order to submit an application packet for the program. Test scores must be included with the completed program application packet that is due by May 20, 2017.
- The ATI TEAS Exam is offered by appointment only. **Cost of the ATI TEAS exam is \$50.00** and you can schedule your ATI TEAS Exam by going to <http://www.gwinnettech.edu/programs/assessment-testing-center/> and clicking on TEAS. If no test dates are showing available online, email the Assessment Office at assessmentoffice@gwinnettech.edu. **ATI TEAS cost will be going up starting Fall 2017.**
- Applicants may take the test one time only.** It is recommended that the test is completed well before the May 20th deadline because there are limited test slots available during Spring Semester. If students are not accepted into the program they have applied to, they can use the TEAS score for two application cycles or they can retest one time each year.
