## ATI TEAS Testing Process Gwinnett Technical College



The Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS) measures basic skills in academic content areas of Mathematics, Reading, Science, English and Language Usage.

**Candidates for Medical Assisting and Veterinary Technology programs are required to take the ATI TEAS Exam before the published file completion deadlines.**

### **SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT TO TAKE THE ATI TEAS EXAM:**

- The ATI TEAS exam must be completed prior to the File Completion Application deadline for your selected program and must be taken at Gwinnett Technical College.
- The ATI TEAS Exam is offered by appointment only. **Cost of the ATI TEAS exam is \$50.00** and you can schedule your ATI TEAS Exam by going to <http://www.gwinnettech.edu/programs/assessment-testing-center/> and clicking on TEAS. If no test dates are showing available online, email the Assessment Office at [assessmentoffice@gwinnettech.edu](mailto:assessmentoffice@gwinnettech.edu). **ATI TEAS cost will be going up starting Fall 2017.**
- GTC allows Medical Assisting and Vet Tech candidates to take the ATI TEAS Exam a maximum of 2 times per application cycle. Students must wait a minimum of 30 days between ATI TEAS Exam testing dates. The highest ATI TEAS Exam score obtained from GTC will be accepted.

**ATI TEAS TEST DETAILS—Time limit is 209 minutes.** Content and sub-content areas are as follows:
