Cardiovascular Technology Degree Application Instructions

Fall 2017 Application and Prerequisite Deadline: May 20, 2017

Step 1: Print the attached **Cardiovascular Technology Degree** Application. Read the instructions and application requirements carefully.

Step 2: Review your Gwinnett Tech Transcript to confirm that all prerequisites are accurately reflected. To review & print your Gwinnett Tech academic transcript:

- Log on to www.gtc-web.org
- Click on "Student/Faculty Secure Area"
- User ID: Enter your student ID or social security number (without hyphens)
- PIN: Enter your birth date in 6-digit format (MMDDYY).
- Click on "Student Services and Financial Aid"
- Click on "Student Records"
- Click on "Academic Transcript"
- Click on "Submit"

NOTE: If any pre-requisites have been taken at other institutions and are not reflected on your Gwinnett Tech transcript, please e-mail RegistrarsOffice@GwinnettTech.edu so that any missing prerequisite issues can be corrected well before the Fall 2017 application deadline **May 20, 2017**.

Step 3: Complete the Health Science Program Essay form located at www.GwinnettTech.edu/enrollment/forms-documents/ under Program Applications & Forms.

Step 4: **SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT TO TAKE THE ATI TEAS EXAM:**

The ATI TEAS exam must be completed prior to the File Completion Application deadline for your selected program. **The minimum score that will be accepted is 70** in order to submit an application packet for the Cardiovascular Technology program. Test scores must be included with the completed program application packet that is due **by May 20, 2017**.

The ATI TEAS Exam is offered by appointment only. **Cost of the ATI TEAS exam is \$50.00 the first time you test and if you choose to take the TEAS Exam a second time at Gwinnett Tech, the cost will be will be \$75.00.** You can schedule your ATI TEAS Exam by going to

<http://www.gwinnettech.edu/programs/assessment-testing-center/> and clicking on TEAS. If no test dates are showing available online, email the Assessment Office at assessmentoffice@gwinnettech.edu.

Applicants may take the ATI TEAS Exam a maximum of 2 times per application cycle at Gwinnett Tech. Students must wait a minimum of 30 days between ATI TEAS Exam testing dates. The highest ATI TEAS Exam score will be accepted.

Imaging Science students can also test at other institutions and have the scores sent electronically from ATI to Gwinnett Tech.

Please be aware that the ATI TEAS exam cost will be going up starting Fall 2017.

Step 5: Complete the **Cardiovascular Technology Degree** Application Form with all required information. Be sure to attach a copy of your current **Gwinnett Tech transcript** you have printed from www.gtc-web.org, your **Health Essay**, and **ATI TEAS Exam results**.

Step 6: Submit completed application packet to the Healthcare Enrollment Team in Building 100, no later than the Fall 2017 Application deadline **May 20, 2017. Incomplete application packets will not be accepted.**

The final selection process will include additional criteria such as, overall GPA (including other schools); prerequisite GPA, Health Essay, ATI TEAS Exam, etc.

Gwinnett Tech must have an official transcript on file for each college previously attended.
