

Instructions for Completing the MOWR Funding Application

1. Go to <http://www.Gafutures.org>
2. Create a new account
 - All Personal Information (Name, DOB, SSN, etc.) must match the records at your high school. (*Homeschooled students must submit the paper application*)
 - **You must enter your SSN when creating your account in order to complete the MOWR Online Application!** (*Students without a valid SSN must submit the paper application*)
3. Once you have created an account, click on the Home button
4. Scroll down to "Trending" on right-hand side
5. Select "Move on When Ready." If you are unable to locate the link under "Trending", follow these steps:
 - Select "Hope & State Aid Programs" from the menu bar
 - Select "State Scholarships and Grants"
 - Select "Move on When Ready"
6. Select "Application Procedure and Deadline"
7. Select link for "**Online Application**" (*Homeschooled students and students without a valid SSN must submit the paper application*)
8. Select "Add a New Application"
9. **Complete and submit Part I of the application.** Be sure to select Gwinnett Technical College and verify all of your personal information, including your name, DOB, and SSN before submitting the application.
10. Hit the Home button and follow Steps 3-6 again
11. Select "View Application Status"
12. Take screenshot that looks like the one below and **send to HSAdmissions@GwinnettTech.edu**
