The Admissions Test contains 91 questions divided into 4 sections:

Reading section – 22 questions to be answered in 45 minutes

Writing section – 21 questions to be answered in 45 minutes

Math section – 28 questions to be answered in 45 minutes

Science section – 20 questions to be answered in 30 minutes

Scores are shown by module and overall.

Schedule an appointment to take the Kaplan Exam

The Kaplan exam must be completed prior to the File Completion deadline for the RN Nursing program and the RN and Nursing Bridge program and must be taken at Gwinnett Technical College.

The Kaplan Exam is offered by appointment only. To schedule a testing appointment, go to

The cost for the Kaplan exam is \$50.00 and the payment can be made in the Assessment Center. **You must pay within 2 days of your registration or your seat will be made available to another student.**

GTC allows competitive health candidates to take the Kaplan Exam a maximum of 2 times per application cycle. Students must wait a minimum of 30 days between Kaplan Exam testing dates. The highest Kaplan Exam score obtained from GTC will be accepted.
