ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This Articulation Agreement is made between Gwinnett Technical College and Walden University and dated this 9th day of January, 2015 (the "Agreement").

I. Parties

A. Walden University

Walden University has supported working professionals in achieving their academic goals and making a greater impact in their professions and their communities. The university provides students with an engaging educational experience that connects them with expert faculty and peers around the world. Walden is the flagship online university in the *Laureate International Universities* network.

II. Purpose

This Agreement outlines the transferability of courses from Gwinnett Technical College to the respective Bachelor programs at Walden University. Specific program-to-program articulations are set forth in Section III below.

III Articulation Specifics

GTC students who successfully complete courses listed in this guide with a grade of 'C' or better and meet the requirements for admission to the respective Walden Bachelor degree program may receive credit. All credits will be converted to the equivalent value for Walden credit.

Important Note: Courses indicated on these tables will be fulfilled, but there may be outstanding credit. Walden requires that 45 of the last 90 quarter credits earned for a bachelor's degree be earned at Walden University. Transfer of credit is subject to change based on curriculum updates by academic leadership.

Courses transferred in to Walden are subject to Transfer of Credit policies including the conversion of semester to quarter credit (1; 1.5) and grade requirements. Students may have credits to make up in their general elective requirement if courses transfer in for less than 5 quarter credit hours.

IV. Term and Termination

This Agreement will automatically renew for additional terms of one year. Should any changes to the Agreement be required, it will be necessary to follow the process outlined in V(F). Either party may terminate this Agreement for any reason with 90 days written notice. Such termination shall not affect the rights of any students participating in any program under this Agreement prior to receipt of such notice. This Agreement will terminate automatically in the event that either party fails to maintain its accreditation status.

V. Other Provisions

- A. <u>Admission to Walden University</u>. Participation in this Agreement does not guarantee any GTC student admission to Walden University. Potential students must apply in accordance with the procedures set forth by the University from time to time.
- B. <u>FERPA</u>. For purposes of this Agreement, pursuant to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA), Walden and GTC will only be permitted to exchange student information with an appropriate release provided by the student. A sample of such release is attached hereto as Attachment A.
- C. <u>Confidential Information</u>. Walden and GTC acknowledge that, during the term of this Agreement and in the course of performing their obligations hereunder, they may disclose to each other certain confidential information and trade secrets relating to their respective past, present and future research, data, business strategies, marketing plans, development and business activities, designs, computer programs and code, systems, customer lists, personnel, student and financial information ("Confidential Information").

Walden and GTC agree that, until such time as the Confidential Information enters the public domain through no fault of their own, they will never, directly or indirectly, use, disseminate, or disclose, any of the Confidential Information disclosed to one of them by or on behalf of the other without the prior written consent of the party to whom the Confidential Information belongs, except as may be required in the course of performing their respective obligations under this Agreement or as required by applicable public records law.

Walden and GTC agree to protect the Confidential Information from use or disclosure using no less than a reasonable degree of care. Upon expiration or termination of this Agreement, or upon the other party's request, Walden and GTC agree to return to the other party to whom the Confidential Information belongs all copies of Confidential Information, and all drawings, documents, records, notebooks, disks, tapes, data residing or recorded in electronic media, and

all other representations of Confidential Information, whether prepared by Walden, GTC, or others.

- D. <u>Enforcement</u>. Gwinnett Technical College and Walden University are the only Parties to this Agreement and are the only Parties entitled to enforce its terms. Nothing in this Agreement gives, or is intended to give, or shall be construed to give or provide any benefit or right, whether directly, indirectly or otherwise, to any third person not a party to this Agreement.
- E. <u>Non-Exclusivity</u>. Gwinnett Technical College and Walden University reserve the right to enter into similar agreements with other institutions.
- F. <u>Annual Review</u>. Gwinnett Technical College and Walden University agree to review the Agreement annually on the anniversary of its signing, unless either party gives notice to the other at an earlier time that modifications or changes have occurred. In the event that changes to the Agreement are required, those changes will be updated in an Addendum that will be attached to the Agreement and signed by both parties.
- G. <u>Notice</u>. Any notice required hereunder shall be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested and shall be deemed given three (3) days after deposit thereof in the U.S. mail (postage prepaid).
- H. <u>Understanding of the Parties</u>. This Agreement sets forth the entire understanding of the parties hereto and supersedes any and all prior agreements, arrangements and understandings, oral or written, of any nature whatsoever, between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.

EDUCATIONAL PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Walden University and Gwinnett Technical College agree to cooperate in the promotion, facilitation and implementation of a partnership which allows employees or alumni of Gwinnett Technical College to pursue programs of higher education through Walden University at a reduced cost.

Partner Employee or Alumnus Benefits

• <u>Tuition Reduction</u>: Eligible Gwinnett Technical College employees or alumni will receive a ten percent (10%) reduction in the cost of course tuition for all Walden programs. This reduction will remain in effect for the duration of the student's enrollment at Walden notwithstanding the termination of this Educational Partnership Agreement or in the event the student ceases to be employed by Gwinnett Technical College. Only one tuition reduction benefit may be applied to tuition. New students enrolling on or after April 14, 2014 may combine the 10% reduction with any one quarterly offer. Cost of tuition is subject to periodic increases at the sole discretion of Walden University.

Proof of Eligibility

It is the responsibility of the Gwinnett Technical College employee or alumnus to request the tuition reduction and provide proof of eligibility. New students may make this request through their Walden Enrollment Advisor; previously-enrolled students may submit their request through the Walden Student Services Team.

This Agreement is not a guarantee that all Gwinnett Technical College employees or alumni desiring admission to Walden will be admitted. All prospective Gwinnett Technical College employee or alumnus students will be subject to the same standard admissions and registration processes as all other prospective Walden students.

Roles and Responsibilities

Walden and Gwinnett Technical College will provide the following as part of the Educational Partnership:

Tuition and Billing

Walden will bill each student directly for tuition and fees, unless otherwise discussed and agreed upon, in writing, between the two parties.

Term and Annual Renewal

This Agreement shall be in effect for the period commencing on January 23, 2015 and ending one (1) year thereafter. The agreement shall renew annually for successive one (1) year periods, unless terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon ninety (90) days advance written notice to the other party.

Student Information

No student information will be shared between Walden University and Gwinnett Technical College.

Confidentiality

Gwinnett Technical College acknowledges that, by virtue of entering into this Agreement and fulfilling the terms of this Agreement, Gwinnett Technical College may have access to certain information of Walden that is confidential and constitutes valuable, special and unique property of Walden. Gwinnett Technical College agrees that it will not, (either during or subsequent to the term of this Agreement), disclose to others, use, copy or permit to be copied, without Walden's express prior written consent, except in connection with the performance of Gwinnett Technical College's duties hereunder, any confidential or proprietary information of Walden.

Intellectual Property Rights Ownership

Both parties acknowledge that any and all patents, design rights, know-how, copyrights, trademarks, trade names and other intellectual property rights included in the course and degree programs and other materials provided by Walden during the course of performing under this Agreement remain the sole property of Walden. The parties agree that they will not use any trade name, trademark, service mark, logo or commercial symbol, or any other proprietary rights of the other party in any manner without the express written permission of the other party.

Choice of Law

This Agreement will be governed by, and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia.
