6.1.2 GT Special Programs

Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act program is a federally funded program that operates a Career Resource Center in Building 100-903 on the campus of Gwinnett Technical College. WIOA provides a variety of services to individuals who are in job search and seeking employment. WIOA career advisors assist WIOA applicants with career decisions as it relates to their employment and training goals. Funding assistance for training expenses is available to qualified Dislocated Workers and Youth and Adults of low income families. Online registration via the Georgia WorkReady Portal begins the application process; eligibility requirements must be met to receive funding. Training is targeted towards jobs in high demand areas in the local labor market.
