6.5.2 GT TCSG Grade Point Average (GPA)

The Gwinnett Technical College adheres to the policy related to Grade Point Average as noted at <https://tcsgeu/tcsgepolicy/files/6.5.2.pdf>.

In addition to the TCSG policy, Gwinnett Technical College stipulates the following: A student's academic standing is based on a cumulative and term grade point average (GPA). All credit hours attempted at Gwinnett Technical College in any program of study are used in calculating the GPA. Credit earned in other institutions, credit by examination, credit by articulation and credit given for developmental studies classes are not used in computing GPA.

The numerical grade points for academic letter grades are as follows:

A..... 4.0	D..... 1.0
B..... 3.0	F 0
C..... 2.0	WF 0

The grades of EX, I, W, TR, AU, AC, S, U, and Z do not have numerical grade points and are not used in calculating the GPA.

The grade of "Z" represents withdrawal from a course before completion due to the COVID-19 emergency. This grade does not have numerical equivalents and will not be calculated in the GPA. This grade is unacceptable credit in a course.
