Transition Steps from Dual Enrollment to Regular Admit Student



APPLICATION:

 Submit an Admissions Application as a Re-Admit student. Scan the QR code the Admissions Application.





SUBMIT:

2. Submit your current in-progress high school transcript

You can have it sent electronically from GaFutures.org
After steps 1 and 2 are completed, the student will be admitted as a "pending admit high school senior." The student has until June 15th to complete step 3.

A home-study dual enrollment student must satisfy the following test score admissions requirements to transition to a regular-admit student after completing high school: (A) Show a college transcript of 12 credits completed with a grade of C or higher in each course or (B) Show a college transcript of ENGL 1101 and MATH 1111 completed with a grade of C or higher or (C) provide official qualifying test scores from SAT or ACT or Accuplacer.

3. Submit your final official high school transcript.



COMPLETE FAFSA:

4. Complete your FAFSA at www.FAFSA.gov

You will not be eligible to receive any financial aid until after your final high school transcript has been received and processed by the college.
