The current requirement for the Veterinary Technology program is Biology 1111/L or BIOL 2107/L and Chemistry 1151/L or 1211/L.

Since the Vet Tech program starts a new cohort only in the fall semester this change will be implemented over the next 3 years as follows: GWINNETT TECH WILL TAKE ANY COMBINATION OF THE CLASSES LISTED BELOW UNTIL FALL 2025 WHEN WE WILL NO LONGER ACCEPT ANY CHEMISTRY CLASSES. APPLICANTS FOR THE FALL 2025 COHORT CAN ONLY USE BIOL 1111/L AND BIOL 1112/L.
